## **Classes**

### **Morning Session            9:30 to 12:30**

#### **Summer Theater Camp with Anne Lape and Brad Poer**

**These sessions will be mixed age and include children from Kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade.**

Our theatre camp this summer is all about helping young performers learn how to express themselves creatively through theatre games, improvisation, storytelling, stand-up comedy- whatever gets students up in front of each other and thinking in new and robust ways! Theatre is, in many ways, the ultimate team sport; and the confidence and social skills that are gained from students working together to create and entertain can be parlayed into more vivid imaginations and profound classroom interactions when the school year comes around again. All of these intellectual and social gains, however, are cleverly disguised as FUN. Each two-week session will culminate in an informal student-generated performance.

### **Afternoon Session        1:00 to 4:00**

#### **Travel through Time with Writing Anne Lape and Cynthia Larson**

**These sessions will be divided into two grade specific groups: K-4 and 5-8.**

Food, Fashion, Field Trips and Fun! Travel through the decades reading and writing about the cultures that shaped the Kalamazoo area. Each two-week session will give students many opportunities to develop new writing projects and work on those they may have already begun. Each session will have a time period theme that will guide our work, as we read, write, take short field trips and create art and other projects that support that period in history.

#### **Sports Camp (Second Session Only) with Karen Anderson**

**These sessions will be mixed age and include children from Kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade.**

The Sports Camp will provide an opportunity for children to focus on volleyball and basketball skills, as well as cooperative group games promoting fitness, good sportsmanship and FUN!! A variety of individual and group activities will be offered. The camp will be limited to 16 participants, so get your registration in ASAP!!

### **Early Day Program        7:30 to 9:30**

### **Late Day Program        4:00 to 5:30**

After school supervised activities for families who need a late pick-up time for their child(ren).

**Refund Policy and Payment**

A refund will not be given unless requested two weeks prior to the opening date of the session for which you have enrolled. We ask that you please not send cash. Checks should be made payable to the Kazoo School. For enrollment to be maintained, the balance of the tuition must be paid by the start of the session for which your child is enrolled.

We ask that parents complete these sections of the application prior to returning the form. These sections must be completed before a student's application can be processed.

**Summer Hours**

**Placement**

Students should register for classes based on the grade they will be entering in the Fall of 2009.

**Enrollment**

The Summer Program presents students with the opportunity to be involved in courses with small class sizes. However, programs that are under enrolled may be canceled prior to the beginning of the session. Should the program you are registered to attend be canceled, we will contact you and provide a full refund.

**Outdoor Time**

Students should expect to spend some portion of the day outside and should dress accordingly. Sunscreen, bug spray, hats, sunglasses and water bottles are recommended.

**Transportation**

Kazoo School does not provide transportation for students.

**Dismissal**

Faculty will only release children to parents/guardians listed on the registration form unless otherwise instructed by that parent/guardian
