



2011-2012 Child Placement Contract for Kazoo School (Preschool only)

This contract is required of all licensed child care/preschool centers by R400.510b of the Michigan Administrative code. The Michigan Department of Consumer and Industry Services is required to inspect the childcare center and enforce the contract based on the terms provided in this contract.

Part 1: Contract provisions provided by childcare facility:

Kazoo School Preschool, as a licensed childcare/preschool facility, will provide the following provisions of the Michigan Administrative Code as required by R400.5 IOB.

R400.5102 Licensee:

Rule 102. All staff and volunteers, including parents that interact with children, will follow the guidelines developed in working with the preschool children at Kazoo School Preschool.

- (2)(b) Kazoo School has developed and implements a written screening policy for all staff and volunteers, including parents, who have contact with children. No volunteer is ever left alone with a child.

R400. 5106 Program

Rule 106. The following criteria are based on the standards required by the State of Michigan for our licensing of Kazoo School Preschool.

- (a) Physical development, including large and small muscle.
 - (b) Social development, including communication skills.
 - (c) Emotional development, including positive self-concept.
 - (d) Intellectual development.
- (2) A center shall permit parents to visit the program for the purpose of observing their children at all times.
 - (3) A center operating with children in attendance for 5 or more continuous hours per day shall provide for daily outdoor play, unless prevented by inclement weather conditions.

- (4) A center shall provide each child under school age in attendance for 5 or more continuous hours a day with an opportunity to rest.
- (5) A center shall provide children less than 3 years of age with an opportunity to rest regardless of the number of hours in care.

Kazoo School Preschool is aligned with Kazoo School's philosophy of education and is dedicated to developing in each child a positive self-image, love of learning, and respect for others.

This educational program provides children an opportunity to learn through hands-on, developmentally appropriate activities in a fun, nurturing and safe environment. It focuses on children's interests, creative arts, imaginative play, themes and project work, nature exploration and conflict resolution skill development.

Each day the child is able to make choices within a variety of learning centers, participate in music, movement, art activities or creative dramatics. Short and long term project work and theme activities are adapted to meet the needs of individual children. Guided learning time will include activities to develop fine and gross motor and conflict resolution skills. The children have daily outdoor play, exploration of nature, organized games and free play.

Each child is required to wash his/her hands prior to snack and after using the bathroom.

Parents are encouraged to become actively involved in the preschool as classroom helpers and committee members.

Parents are responsible on a daily basis, for providing a healthy snack for their child.

Part 2: Upon signing:

Upon signing this agreement, the parent, legal guardian, or responsible adult and preschool facility, agree to comply with the provisions stated in this contract.
